


Learning Sessions


Snapshot Sessions

Length: 45 minutes



What Makes a PechaKucha **Presentation** Great?






Funder Labs

Audience: Education grantmakers and only grantmakers are invited to participate.






SELECTION CRITERIA

 - Play a game




