

## A BRIEF HISTORY



### When did BPL & BPLA begin this venture?

- 2003: Viv White visits Elliot Washor at The Met in the US
- 2005: Elliot tours Australia to explain the Big Picture Learning Design
- 2006: Big Picture Learning Australia established (over 50 BP campuses across Australia by 2022)
- 2016: 3 x BP senior students ask Viv for a way to finish school Big Picture-style AND get into university
- 2017: The BP Graduation Portfolio pathway to university is piloted for Sophie, Hamish and David
- 40% of Australian universities partner with BPLA to accept our graduates

## A BRIEF HISTORY



- 2019: BPLA and the University of Melbourne design a set of assessment measures for a new credential for BPL graduates
- 2020: The International Big Picture Learning Credential is successfully piloted in Australia
- 2021: Elliot explores how to transfer the IBPLC to the US
- 2022 23: BPL US pilots the credential in Los Angeles, New York State, the Pacific Northwest and Massachusetts

## passion

Each student has a personalised learning plan endorsed by their family and designed around their interests and passions, with links to the curriculum.



Students take courses and work on a variety of projects in areas of personal interest that they design and manage.



Students learn in small groups of 17 known as an 'advisory' where there is a culture of belonging, support and respect.



They also complete practical projects while on internship with an expert mentor in the community, to gain experience in a field of interest.



Students collect evidence of their learning in a portfolio and regularly present their work at a public exhibition to teachers, mentors, peers and family. This is the basis of their assessment throughout school.



The International Big Picture Learning Credential is an education passport awarded to all senior students on pathways to employment, training and university.





## How is this credential different to conventional final-year assessments?



This new credential is intrinsically linked to the Big Picture Learning Design where:

- Academic results appear alongside personalized information
- Student work is visible rather than obscured behind a numerical score
- Student agency and depth is evident in their online portfolio and video profile
- Student skills, knowledge, experiences, qualities are captured through what they can do, make, say, show or write
- There is no standardized curriculum nor assessment that privileges one type of learning over another, nor ranks one student against another
- Teacher judgements are psychometrically evaluated to ensure reliability



### Some International Data



#### In the US in 2022- 2023:

- 114 BPL students from 8 schools are participating in the pilot of the IBPLC
- They completed the first round of assessment in Dec 2022 and will complete their final round in June 2023

#### In Australia in 2023:

 886 Year 11 & 12 students across Australia, are registered to graduate with an IBPLC

#### In Kenya in 2022- 2023:

4 students are registered to graduate with an IBPLC.
