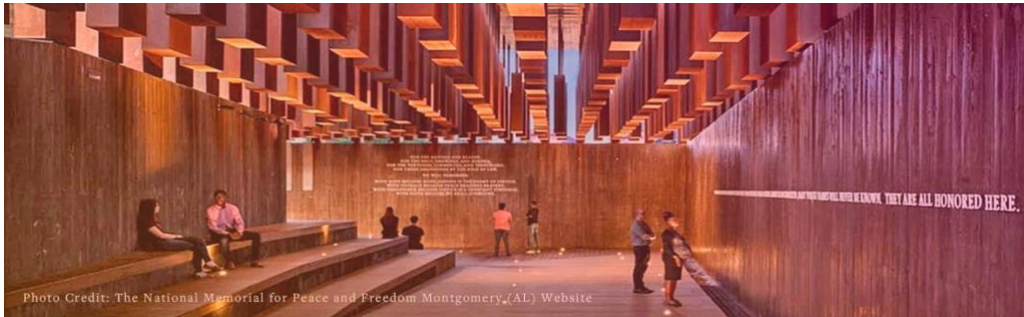

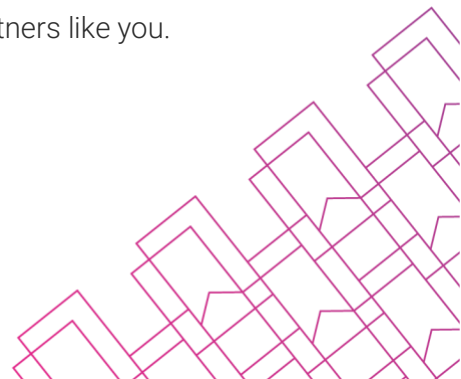
July 24-26, 2024 in Montgomery, Alabama

We are very excited to engage in deep reflection and connection with partners like you.



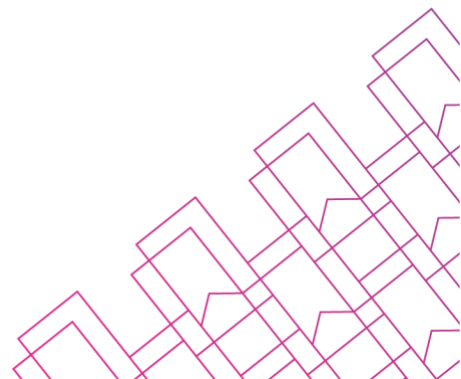
ABOUT GRANTMAKERS FOR EDUCATION
